Alternatively, spot Uluru and Kata Tjuta from the air, with an optional upgrade scenic flight.

In the evening, the hallmark experience of The Ghan Expedition begins. Your clients will under a blanket of stars at the Alice Springs Telegraph Station, with red earth at their feet and white tablecloths under their fingertips. This will be a night to remember.

Coober Pedy: Venture into the weird and wonderful opal mining township of Coober Pedy, where more than half of the residents live underground. 


PERTH TO SYDNEY



From ocean to ocean, the Indian Pacific has been crossing Australia, connecting west and east, for over 50 years. This incredible transcontinental journey travels from city to outback to city, highlighting the diverse landscapes of this beautiful country, from urban skyscapes to arid plains. Departing Perth, the first day is spent embracing life on train, and as the Indian Pacific travels overnight your clients will wake up in the outback with stops in Kalgoorlie and Cook as they travel across the Nullarbor Plain. They'll pass through South Australia, stopping in the Barossa Valley for an incredible dining experience, as well as Broken Hill and the Blue Mountains on their journey towards Sydney.

Kalgoorlie: Your clients will delve into this mining town's fascinating past and present, with a visit to the region's gold-rush era, now modern-day, Super Pit mine. The choice is theirs on how they want to explore Kalgoorlie with a range of Off Train Experiences, including morning refreshments.

Cook: Late evening, the train stops at the almost-ghost-town of Cook for a nightcap, late-night bonfire and stargazing experience.

Barossa Valley: Visit the world-renowned, wine-producing region of the Barossa Valley. A traditional 'Firing of the Barrel' display is part of the evening, as well as a food and wine pairing curated by Executive Chef Owen Andrews, highlighting regional produce and traditional methods that reflect the story of the Barossa. Adelaide & Surrounds: Your clients can choose to spend the afternoon indulging in an epicurean experience at Penfolds Magill State. Or visit the McLaren Vale wine region to sample fine South Australian wines before an indulgent meal. Or try a cheese or gin tasting in the charming Adelaide Hills village of Hahndorf before feasting at Haus, a German restaurant showcasing the best in local produce. Alternatively, visit the Adelaide Central Market for a tour and exclusive sit-down dinner.

Cook: This is a great opportunity for your clients to stretch their legs and explore the old railway town of Cook. Use the self-auided map provided to walk around the town and explore.

Rawlinna: Stop at Rawlinna on the fringe of Australia's largest sheep station for a signature dinner under a thousand stars. Your clients will arrive at sunset, where the quiet outpost of Rawlinna comes to life with an al fresco long table set up and a seat for everyone to enjoy the uninterrupted views (seasonal-summer months).

ALICE SPRINGS Selegraph Station



The Alice Springs Telegraph Station Historical Reserve marks the original site of the first European settlement in Alice Springs. Established in 1871 to relay messages between Darwin and Adelaide along the Overland Telegraph Line which connected Australia's population centres with the north of the country and Britain using the undersea telegraph network. Before the telegraph line was built, a message to England would have to travel by boat, taking 3-4 months each way. After the telegraph line was built, morse code messages could reach London in as little as 5 hours — slow by today's standards, but revolutionary for people of the 19th century.

THE HISTORIC MUSEUM

Guided Tours through the heritage museum and precinct are great ways for your clients to immerse themselves in the history of the Telegraph Station, the origins of Alice Springs as a town and the Stolen Generation of the Bungalow era of the 1930s. Learn about the back story, and inner workings of the original Telegraph Station and Post Office, as well as experience a working display of Meidinger batteries — replicas of those that powered the Overland Telegraph Line back in the 1870s — which is unique in the southern hemisphere.

SAL SALIS NINGALOO REEF



Where the outback meets the coral waters, that's where you'll find Sal Salis, a unique setting from which to explore Western Australia's Ningaloo Reef. With just 15 eco-luxury wilderness tents, and a honeymoon tent, hidden amongst the dunes, there is no better way to experience one of Australia's best kept natural secrets.

Open from March to mid-November, the camp lies amongst the dunes, with the coral reef and its marine inhabitants just a few metres offshore. Ningaloo is acknowledged as one of the best places in the world to swim with the world's largest fish, the whale shark, as these gentle giants migrate through here every year. These waters also are visited by humpback whales, another highlight for guests. The coastal dunes and gorges, in the Cape Range National Park, attract land dwellers as well, with red kangaroos, wallaroos, echidnas, emus and more seen in and around the camp.

Getting Here

BY AIR

Qantas fly to Exmouth (Learmonth) with connections from most capital cities. Air and road transfers are available from RAAF Learmonth Airport (LEA) and must be pre-booked.

BY ROAD

The drive from Perth can take up to 13 hours. Also please note that there is a 'no drive after dark' policy, within the Cape Range National Park, due to the high number of animals on the road during this time. The drive from RAAF Learmonth Airport (LEA) is 90 minutes and from Exmouth town one hour.

GUIDED GORGE WALKS

Early morning walks into the Cape Range National Park provide a rugged and beautiful contrast to the reef and beach activities.

Guided walks usually depart before sunrise, while temperatures are cooler, and take in both Mandu Mandu and Yardie Creek Gorges. Keep an eye out for land mammals including red kangaroos, echidna and black-footed rock wallabies. Emus are also frequently sighted.

SEA KAYAKING

Guided forays across the reef reveal an array of colourful residents including fish, sea turtles, reef sharks, rays and corals.

Kayaks are the perfect vessel and your clients will be shown how to safely navigate the reef without impacting the ecosystem. Our guided kayak-snorkel tours go further offshore and drop anchor in the sand to explore the deeper lagoons. In Ningaloo Reef these are among the best snorkelling spots with soft corals, sponges, wobbegong sharks and marine fish galore. Also between August and October, and only metres from the reef, humpback whales migrating along this coast really are something to see.

SWIM WITH THE WORLD'S LARGEST FISH

Each year between mid-March and August these slow-moving, gentle, filter-feeding giants migrate past Ningaloo Reef.

Sal Salis offers whale shark swims with select local partners for an additional cost. This needs to be pre-booked as the boats do fill up months in advance.

The whale shark experience begins with a transfer to Tantabiddi Boat Ramp (about 25 minutes' drive) our clients will meet their experienced crew and enjoy morning tea as they motor out into the Indian Ocean, aided by a spotter aircraft that relays sightings back to the skipper. The crew will help them get kitted out with the proper equipment and provide a thorough briefing.

During the course of the day our crew will also keep an eye out for turtles, dolphins, dugongs, rays and sea birds for an additional viewing pleasure. Plus there is usually time for a back of the reef snorkel. To enhance the experience even more, a delicious lunch is provided featuring fresh Western Australian produce.






